**Swedish Microwave Days 2016 will be arranged at  
Konsert & Kongress in Linköping on March 15-16 2016**

*The GigaHertz Symposium* is a biennial symposium in the field of GigaHertz technology. This will be the 13th GigaHertz Symposium after its start in Linköping 1992 and the previous symposium was held in Gothenburg in 2014 as part of the Swedish Microwave Days.

*The AntennEMB Symposium* is the radio science symposium on Antennas and Computational Electromagnetics organized by SNRV (Svenska Nationalkommittén för Radiovetenskap, the Swedish URSI Committee). The AntennEMB Symposium has been organized on a regular basis for more than a decade and the previous symposium was held in Gothenburg 2014 as part of the Swedish Microwave Days.

The aim of the Swedish Microwave Days is to bring together people from industry, academia and other research oriented organizations. The scope is broad, ranging from devices to systems, from sub GHz frequencies up to several THz, antenna technology, applications, theory and measurement techniques, computational methods, optimization algorithms and programming techniques.

## Symposium Format

The format of the symposium combines invited keynote talks with contributions from the symposium participants in the form of oral and interactive forum poster presentations. Application seminars by exhibitors will also be included as part of the symposium program.

## Abstract Submission – Deadline November 20

A one page abstract (PDF-format preferred) including title, author affiliation, summary of results and conclusion, figures and references should be submitted before November 20, 2015. An abstract template is available for download at [www.microwavedays.se](http://www.microwavedays.se).
